Active Ageing, Quality of Life and Gender

ENCAGE-CM is an R&D activity programme developed by a consortium coordinated by the Research Group on Ageing at the Spanish National Research Council (GIE-CSIC), and centered in the Community of Madrid.

MISSION

The ENCAGE-CM programme aims to position the Community of Madrid as a model in Active Ageing through research, training, and knowledge transference and dissemination on active ageing, quality of life and gender.

Activities

Research

The goal is to advance in the knowledge about active ageing and, from a gender perspective, including to understand how older people (in their diverse residential backgrounds), as well as social and business agents, view active ageing. With this purpose, combined actions are being developed in order to maintain and spread the collaboration, through:

- Projects: Longitudinal Study Ageing in Spain Project (ELES, CSIC); the construction of Active Ageing in Spain (ENVACES, CSIC); Business and Active Ageing (FEyS); Social well-being, Ageing and gender (UC3M); Active Ageing and Quality of Life from a comparative perspective: Mexico, Spain and Argentina (UNAM, México); Active ageing and citizenship (CSIC-UNAM); Successful Ageing, social support and ethnicity in older people from Arica and Parinacota (UTA); Contextual influences in ageing stereotypes (UFV).

- Networks: Continuity, dynamization and consolidation of the current networks, in which consortium, national (Spanish Research Group in Quality of Life and Ageing CSIC-ISCI; Institute of Gender Studies-UC3M; REDISSEC; CIBERNED) and international researchers (Active Ageing in Ibero-America, Interdisciplinary University Seminar on Ageing and old age-UNAM, RIIIES-AUIP, ISQOLS, CHRODIS) are involved.

Training

Teaching actions are established and framed in a Specific Training Plan on ageing and quality of life, from a gender perspective, aimed at training, recruitment and mobility of Graduate and Post-Doctoral researchers, with the purpose of favouring the creation, exchange and dissemination of knowledge and experiences between the consortium participants, in the context of the institutional relations at the Community of Madrid.

Results transference and dissemination

Exchange and transference of scientific knowledge to productive sectors and social and political agents is fostered to design, introduce and manage active ageing and quality of life policies from a gender perspective, especially at the Community of Madrid.

We promote knowledge dissemination through diverse in-person events (meetings, symposiums, seminars, ...), webpages and scientific literature.
